**HOURS:** 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

**SET UP:** Begins at 9:00 a.m. unless other arrangements have been made with you.

**INFORMATION CENTER & FIRST AID FOR THE EVENT WILL BE AT THE REGISTRATION TENT**

**All vendors must be completely set up no later than 10:30 a.m.**

**BOOTHS CAN BEGIN CLOSING DOWN NO EARLIER THAN 3:00 P.M.**

Vendors are responsible for cleanup of their areas.

**All vendors must be off site no later than 4:30 p.m.**

- **All vendors and program participants must check-in with a Kiwanis member at the Vendor Vehicle Entrance or at the Registration Tent.**
  - **All donated raffle items should be provided at check-in or arrangements made to provide prior to the event**
- **Vendors must supply their own tables, chairs, equipment and tents/ canopies unless other arrangements have been made with you.**
  - **All vehicles not needed should be parked in the vendor parking lot no later than 10:45am**
- **Please ensure your tent is secure with sandbags or stakes in the case of windy weather.**
- Kiwanis Club or the Town of Holly Springs is not responsible for any damage, loss of property, etc. In other words, it is your responsibility to secure your booth area. **If you need assistance, please see someone at the Registration Tent. The Holly Springs Police and Fire Departments will also be in attendance.**
- **If giving out candy, items must be manufacturer sealed.**
- **Tickets are required for Pizza slice, Hot Dog & Chips, SnoBalls and Drink\* items. This requirement is not for all vendors—only the concession tents distributing these items.**

\*Drinks provided/ sold by Kiwanis.
- All children will have a hand stamp if they have registered and received a basic packet of free tickets that enable them to enjoy KA Day. If your booth requires a ticket (mentioned above) and an attendee does not have a ticket, then you must send the attendee back to the Registration Table (they may have used up their free tickets or have lost them).
- Useful supplies to have on hand are scissors, bungee cords, and duct tape. All vendors are responsible to bring their own supplies and equipment to operate their booth area.
